- There is a poetry competition due before Easter- the theme is "the Environment"- with an emphasis on biodiversity. Can pupils write a poem on the environment, or indeed any other topic they choose? We will put them on display for World Earth Day, later in the year.
- Children may do a project on a subject of interest to them, based on classwork (R3- Ancient Greece/ Medieval Ireland, Rang 4- An Iodáil, R5/6: 1916; WW2), or on any topic which is of interest.
