

• New Drumcondra Primary Tests Testing- Trialacha Dhroim Chonrach-This year, your child in Rang 1-6 will take the new Drumcondra Maths and English tests and we will share the results with you. You may see differences between your child's results on the new tests and their results on older tests. Because so many were scoring so highly in the old version, the tests have been updated and changed. Also, children from R3-6 will complete their assessments in ipads, giving less opportunity to pupil to change answers. With the new norms and way of doing test, scores may be lower.

All test scores are only *estimates* of a child's true achievement level, based on a particular set of questions on a particular day.

It's not the whole picture and doesn't take into account learning styles or intelligences. How a child is working in class and the standard of their work is far more likely to have an impact on their future results at secondary school.

STens: STens are scores 1-10 which give a rough idea of where performance lies, with around 5 being average. It is possible for two children to have standard scores just one or two points apart, yet to have different STens.

It is important to praise and encourage, and to talk positively about learning and achievements. "Mol an óige agus tiocfaidh sí"
